Easy-to-access baskets and trays keep everyday supplies at your fingertips—and ensure a neat and tidy bathroom.

1 CLEAR ACRYLIC ORGANIZERS tuck inside a stylish basket to organize nail polish and other beauty accessories. Shot glasses serve as creative holders for cotton swabs and small tools.

2 A DECORATIVE TRAY on the vanity top holds beauty supplies in style. “If you have a lot of items, you can use a multitier pie rack to store several levels of makeup or skin-care products,” professional organizer Lorie Marrero says.

3 LABELED BASKETS stored on open shelves hold specific categories of beauty supplies, such as hair styling or bath and shower products, and make items easier to grab than when inside a closed cabinet. “If it’s something you use every day, store it out in the open or make it easily accessible,” professional organizer Kathy Jenkins says.



great idea

Keeping a small bathroom organized can be tricky, but the Compact Vanity (base starts at \$2,093) from robern.com packs tons of storage into a tiny space. The sleek aluminum-and-glass vanity is only 18 inches deep and 21–27 inches wide and can be outfitted with a slim drawer insert, a hair-dryer holder, and an in-drawer element with three outlets for plugging in and charging electrical devices.
